

Mesa County's 16 Road Guardrail Project

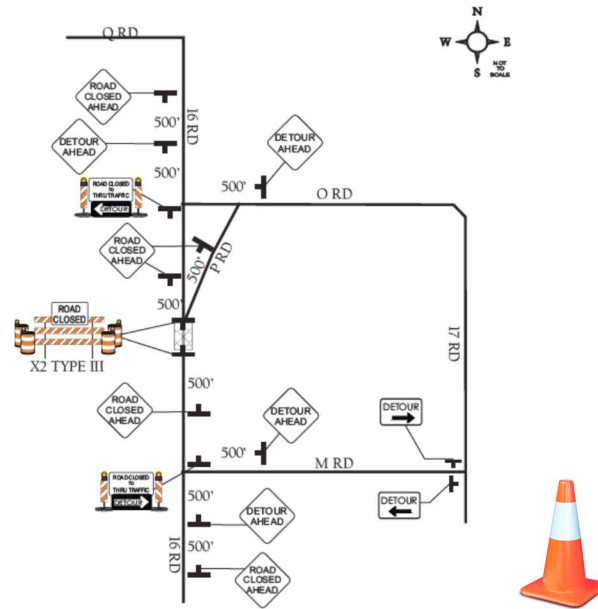
